#### Rule 4 - continued

The winner of the third match bowls against player in position # 1, while the loser finishes third.

The winner of the final match is the 2015 Georgia State USBC WBA Queen / Senior Queen, while the loser finishes second.

- 5. Contestants MUST report no later than one-half (1/2) hour prior to shift time and must show current USBC WBA card or a paid receipt. Entry will be confirmed.
- 6. Qualified subs within the same division will be allowed with written consent of original entrant.
- 7. Participants may enter tournament only once. Check box on page two of the entry form to indicate the tournament you want to enter (Queens/Senior Queens).
- Premature termination of the tournament brought about by reason beyond the control of the Georgia State USBC WBA shall cause the foregoing prize schedule to be pro-rated in accordance with the number of entrants who have bowled.
- 9. Tournament games cannot be re-bowled, except as authorized by the tournament manager, when scores are irretrievably lost in an automatic scoring device.
- 10. The Queens Management will act upon any problems that are not covered in these rules. The decision of the Queens Management will be final.
- 11. Suitable attire is required while participating in the Queens and Senior Queens Tournament. NO SHORT SHORTS OR SHORT SKIRTS allowed on Saturday or Sunday. No Denim of any kind allowed on Sunday. Semi-FINALIST MUST wear full-length dress slacks or appropriate length skirts. No Denim of any kind allowed on Sunday. It is the discretion of the Queens Tournament to determine the appropriate length or both shorts and skirts. Failure to abide by this rule will result in bowler being disqualifed and loss of any prize monies.

# Georgia State USBC WBA Annual Queens Tournament Rules 34th Queens and 13th Senior Queens

#### RETAIN TOURNAMENT RULES FOR REFERENCE

### TOURNAMENT RULES - USBC CERTIFIED

1. Members of the Georgia State USBC WBA with an adult certified 160 average or higher are eligible to participate in the Georgia State USBC Queens or Senior Queens Tournament. Past participants who no longer carry a 160 average will be allowed to bowl in the current tournament provided they have participated in any GWBA Queens Tournaments since 1988. All others excluded.

Postmark to determine accepted entries.

\*\*\*SIGNED AVERAGE VERIFICATION REQUIRED WITH AN ENTRY\*\*\*
Average as of January 1, 2015 of 21 ganes or more will be allowed
provided it s verified with entry.

Members 50 years of age or older by February 6, 2015 will be eligible to enter Senior Queens Tournament.

- 2. Entry Fee will be \$55.00. Expense/Bowling Fee: \$25.00 Prize Fund: \$30.00. Certified Checks or Money Orders Preferred. No Entry Fees will be refunded. A \$30.00 fee will be added for any returned personal checks. No cash please! All prize monies will be returned 100% and will be presented at the conclusion of bowling during the crowning ceremony on March 1, 2015.
- 3. All entrants will draw for lanes. Queens & Senior Queens will bowl together on Saturday with scores being kept separately. Sunday semi-finals and Stepladder finals, Queens and Senior Queens will be separated.
- 4. All entrants will bowl six (6) games across twelve (12) lanes on Saturday, February 28, 2015. At the end of the six (6) games, the number will be cut by 50%. If odd number, the number will be rounded up. The top 50% will return on Sunday, March 1, 2015 to bowl the Semi-Finals. Scores from the qualifying squad will not carry over to the Semi-Finals.

Semi Finals - Lanes will once again be drawn. Bowler will bowl three games across six (6) lanes. Total pins for the three (3) game set will determine the top five (5) positions.

Finals - Bowler in the top five (5) positions will bowl in one (1) game Stepladder Finals. In case of a tie for any roll-off position, a two frame roll-off will be held.

The Player in position # 5 bowling against player in position # 4. The winner bowls against player in position # 3, while the loser finishes fifth.

The winner of the second match bowls against player in position # 2, while the loser finishes fourth.
