SUBJECT: Hosting State Bowling Jamboree

The Georgia State Bowling Council asks any association in Georgia that is interested in hosting the 2012 Annual Bowling Jamboree on August 4-7 to **submit** a proposal to either of the contacts listed below **no later than July 15, 2011**. The accompanying form may be used to submit your proposal. The State Bowling Council will select the site for each future Jamboree and that decision will be briefed to the Georgia State BA and WBA at the next meeting of each of those organizations.

The criteria for hosting a State Jamboree are:

- A hotel must be available that can accommodate a minimum fifty room reservation block.
- The hotel must have meeting rooms available, one of which can accommodate dinner seating for up to 150 people.
- The hotel must have meal service or catering (buffet or served) available for potentially 150 people. (Guarantee to be made within two weeks of the event)
- The hotel must also accommodate a breakfast meeting (buffet or served) on the Sunday morning of the designated weekend for approximately 75 people. (Guarantee of 60)
- The Jamboree weekend is traditionally the first weekend in August.
- There is usually a golf outing planned for the Friday morning of the Jamboree weekend.
- There is usually a bowling event on the Saturday afternoon of the designated weekend.
- There is usually a hospitality room provided on Friday evening and Saturday afternoon (after the meetings are adjourned.)
- There is usually some form of entertainment provided after the dinner on Saturday evening.
- The host association(s) will establish a joint association Jamboree council, that will report to the bowling council the progress made toward hosting the Jamboree weekend.

Meeting room requirements are:

- Friday afternoon at 3:00, 4:00, and 5:00 that will accommodate up to twenty people.
- Friday evening a room that will accommodate up to 60 people (table or theater seating, podium).
- Saturday morning (usually includes coffee and water) and afternoon that will accommodate up to 150 people (theater seating, with a podium and microphone).
- Saturday evening that will accommodate up to 150 people (dinner seating, head table with riser, podium, and microphone).
- Sunday morning that will accommodate up to 75 people (breakfast seating, podium).
- Sunday morning that will accommodate up to 20 people (classroom seating).
