Sessions will be at 4 p.m. on September 7th and Noon on September 8th. You're allowed to enter both sessions but can only cash once. The cost for one session of the tournament is \$34. The best part of the tournament is you bowl 4 games and discard the lowest of the 4 to come up with your total series. How often do you get to do that??
